

Calculation for the U.S.

Assuming there are approximately [1,450 Hindu temples in the U.S.](#), we estimated:

1. Number of Temples:

- Small Temples (65%): 943 temples
- Medium Temples (25%): 362 temples
- Large Temples (10%): 145 temples

2. Annual Milk Usage

- Small Temples: $943 \text{ temples} \times 2 \text{ gallons/day} \times 365 \text{ days} = 688,390 \text{ gallons/year}$
- Medium Temples: $362 \text{ temples} \times 4 \text{ gallons/day} \times 365 \text{ days} = 528,520 \text{ gallons/year}$
- Large Temples: $145 \text{ temples} \times 8 \text{ gallons/day} \times 365 \text{ days} = 423,400 \text{ gallons/year}$

3. Total Milk Usage in the US:

$688,390 + 528,520 + 423,400 = 1,640,310 \text{ gallons/year}$
